



Environmental Primary Education Program Ambon - Implemented "Ambon Green and Clean"

In 2010 a team of SSVA has developed a intensive program to teach 200 elementary schools about environmental issues. The municipality facilitated a longer teaching semester on the schools. In 2011 en 2012 the project was expanded with more teaching material, training programs for the teachers themselves and activities for civilians.

Schools were challenged to become "green". In november 2012 the first three Awards were given to succesful schools during the EcoExpo. The municipality of Ambon is the first municipality in Indonesia with this green school concept.
